

ALERT: If making changes in a Complex Data Type

A number of complex data types are composed of properties that are NOT available for general use, for example, an AnnotationDate is intended for use only by Annotation. In order to prevent these from showing up as options for a data type on a property, we have changed the property status to OFF.

If you make any edits (this includes documentation edits) to a complex data type which uses one of these classes as a property, they will lose their link to the property and automatically be assigned "AbstractDEPRECATED". To reset these to the appropriate data type you must do the following:

1. Change the property flag to ON for each class used (check the box)
2. Edit the parent complex data type
3. Change the property flag to OFF for each class used (uncheck the box)

As of 2016-07-16 the list of Complex Data Types with the property value set to OFF include:
